

Technical Excursion 1: Lilla Edet – Trollhättan Locks

Welcome to the technical excursion visiting the locks of Trollhättan and the hydropower dam Lilla Edet. We will travel by bus to Trollhättan where we will start with a tour of the historical locks of which the first opened year 1800, to the once used today, opened 1916. After the tour we will have a presentation regarding the new locks in Trollhättan, which are still in the stage of planning. Our host for this visit is Sjöfartsverket – the operator of the locks.



After lunch we will travel to Lilla Edet, which is one out of four hydropower dams in the river Göta Älv, draining the largest lake in Sweden, Vänern. In Lilla Edet we will get a presentation by the owner Vattenfall on the ongoing re-construction where the spillways are being replaced. After the presentation we will have look around on site before the bus travels back to the Swedish Congress and Convention Center.
