

Study Tour 3 -

Älvkarleby

Day 1:

Note! New departure time, departure from Cityterminalen at 07.30 am.

This study tour will start in Stockholm, from which we will take the bus to the laboratory of Vattenfall Research and Development in Älvkarleby. We will see the experimental embankment dam, which was built with six built-in defects. These defects were then attempted to be detected using different kinds of methods. We will also see other research projects around the laboratory as well as visiting the hydropower dam.

After our visit at Älvkarleby we will go to Sala Silvermine, there we start with a guided tour of the mine. The mining here is believed to have started in the end of the 15th century. The temperature in the mine is around 2°C, so don't forget to bring warm clothes. After the tour, dinner will be served 155 meters down in the mine. The room where we will have dinner will have a temperature of around 18°C.

After dinner, we will drive to the nearby city of Västerås, where we will stay for the night.

The morning will start with a bus ride to Forsviks bruk where we will start off with lunch. After lunch we will get a guided tour of the area where we will learn about the industrial history of Forsviks bruk. The earliest written evidence of industry in the area is from year 1410 which lasted until 1977 when the last industry closed.

After our visit at Forsviks bruk we will drive to Lake Hornborga (Hornborgarsjön), where we will stop for coffee. Lake Hornborga is situated in a nature reserve and is famous in Sweden for the high number of cranes that stop by every spring. At this time of year, the cranes will have already flown north, but Lake Hornborga is still a home for many other beautiful birds.

After the coffee break, we will leave for Swedish Exhibition and Congress Centre in Gothenburg, were the tour ends. If you are staying at another hotel then Hotel Gothia Towers, you will need to find transportation to your hotel. We will of course help you find a taxi or help you look up public transportation if you wish.
